PAC / Ride America Qualifications

The RPHC Year End Awards Program is designed to recognize and encourage active participation by the membership to keep our club functioning successfully, and to recognize and encourage those who use their American Paint Horse in a variety of activities.

This qualification description is for you to use to assure that you are eligible to be considered for a RPHC Year End Award and recognition for your and your horse's accomplishments.

1. This qualification description is for you to use to insure that you are eligible to be considered for a RPHC Year End Award and recognition for your/your horse's accomplishments.
2. The deadline that your qualifications must be met is on or before the November business meeting. Any qualifications met after the November business meeting date will not be valid for Year End Awards.
3. All Rainier Paint Horse Club 2006 Year End Awards Qualifications and Rules apply. It is your responsibility to make sure you understand the rules, meet the qualifications, select the appropriate division and category, turn in applicable forms, and keep accurate records.
4. Membership in RPHC is required as follows: The registered owner(s) and/or lessee as described in the APHA Rule Book, of the nominated horse/rider's horse and the rider must be a member in good standing for all divisions and categories.
5. Points and/or ride time accumulate starting November 1, 2005 if your membership was renewed by February 1, 2006. Thereafter points accumulate when your membership becomes active.
6. Only horses registered with the APHA, Regular or Breeding Stock Registries, may be used to qualify for awards.
7. One Horse/one rider combination for point accumulation.
8. The ADULT owner/lessee must attend a minimum of three general business meetings within the calendar year.
9. Year End Awards are presented at the RPHC Year End Banquet. Every attempt should be made to attend the Year End Awards Banquet. Awards will not be mailed and will be held for one month only. Awards will be forfeited if not claimed in that time.
10. The ADULT owner/lessee must actively participate on at least two committees (actively means attend all committee meetings or do a major job on that committee) or work at two club events or a combination thereof.
11. A member who acts as a Board Member, Committee Chairperson, NWCC Delegate, Zone One Delegate, or who sponsors a class at the next Rainier-O-Rama is an alternative to only one of the two qualifications listed in number 8 & 10.
12. YOUTHS, 10 AND OVER, MUST FULFILL TWO REQUIREMENTS IN ORDER TO QUALIFY FOR A YEAR END AWARD. FOR ONE REQUIREMENT, YOUTHS MUST ATTEND A MINIMUM OF ONE YOUTH MEETING OR WORK AT A MINIMUM OF ONE YOUTH FUNCTION/EVENT. THE SECOND REQUIREMENT CAN BE FULFILLED BY ATTENDING A SECOND YOUTH MEETING, WORKING AT ANY YOUTH OR CLUB FUNCTION/EVENT OR BY ATTENDING ONE RPHC GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING.

APHA Qualifications

1. **RESPONSIBILITIES:** All RPHC current Year End Awards Qualifications and Rules apply. It is your responsibility to make sure you understand the rules, meet the qualifications, select the appropriate division and category, turn in applicable forms, and keep accurate records.
2. **DEADLINE:** The deadline that your qualifications must be met is on or before November 20th of the current year. Any qualifications met after the November 20th date will not be valid for current year Year End Awards.
3. **START/END:** Points and ride time accumulate starting November 1 if your membership was renewed by February 1 of the current year. Thereafter points and ride time accumulate when your membership becomes active.
4. **MEMBERSHIP:** RPHC membership is required as follows: The registered owner(s) or lessee as described in the APHA Rule Book, of the nominated horse AND the rider must be a member in good standing for all divisions and categories.
5. **APHA REGISTRATION:** Only horses registered with the APHA, Regular or Breeding Stock Registries, may be used to qualify for awards.
6. One horse/one rider combination for point and ride time accumulation.

7. AWARDS: Year End Awards are presented at the RPHC Year End Banquet. Every attempt should be made to attend the Year End Awards Banquet. Awards will not be mailed and will be held for one month only. Awards will be forfeited if not claimed in that time.
8. ALTERNATIVE FOR ONE REQUIREMENT: A member who is active as a Board Member, active Committee Chairperson, active NWCC Delegate, active Zone One Delegate, or who sponsors a class at the current year Rainier-O-Rama is an alternative to only one of the two qualifications listed in rule number 9 or rule number 10.
9. ADULT REQUIREMENTS: For an ADULT award division the adult must:
 - a. Attend a minimum of three general business meetings within the calendar year.
 - b. Actively participate on at least two committees (actively means attend all committee meetings or do a major job on that committee) or work at two club events or a combination thereof.
10. YOUTH REQUIREMENTS: For a YOUTH award division, youth age 10 and over must:
 - a. Attend two youth meetings per year.
 - b. Attend and participate in two approved activities per year.
 - c. Be accompanied by an adult family member at every function and event that the youth member is participating.
 - d. All youth members under the age of 16 will have a family member present at all functions and events. *(All requests for exceptions to this policy will be submitted to the board in writing and all exceptions to this policy if granted will be presented by the board in writing.)*

NOTE: The APHA qualifications will take effect for all RPHC Year End Awards divisions effective 11/01/05.

13. All current year RPHC Year End Awards Rules apply. It is your responsibility to make sure you understand the rules, meet the qualifications, select the appropriate division and category, turn in applicable forms, and keep accurate records.

Category Rules and Descriptions

Category: Paint Points

Description: For those that show at NWCC approved shows.

Rules:

1. All RPHC current Year End Awards Qualifications and Rules apply. It is your responsibility to make sure you understand the rules, meet qualifications, select the appropriate division and category, turn in applicable forms, and keep accurate records.
2. Points earned cannot be included when logging time for pleasure/trail category during the same event.
3. Only NWCC points and Futurity Points earned at NWCC approved shows will count.
4. NWCC Year End Award rules and point system apply with these exceptions:
 - a. No minimum of 10 NWCC points must be earned to qualify for an award.
 - b. No minimum number of classes or no minimum number of categories must be exhibited in.

Category: PAC (Paint Alternative Competition)

Description: For those that show at other than recognized breed shows. AQHA, APHA and Pinto shows, etc. do not count for PAC. Shows that count include, but are not limited to 4-H, Washington State Horseman, WSH Zone, Open, Schooling, Fairs, Reining, Team Penning, Hunter/Jumper, etc. Shows do not need to be PAC approved by APHA.

Rules:

1. All RPHC current Year End Awards Qualifications and Rules apply. It is your responsibility to make sure you understand the rules, meet qualifications, select the appropriate division and category, turn in applicable forms, and keep accurate records.
2. Only shows appropriately logged will count towards PAC points. Results are logged on the honor system and must be submitted by the Year End Awards deadline. Use the log included in this packet.
3. Points earned cannot be included when logging time for pleasure/trail category during the same event.
4. NWCC point system applies with the exception of 4-H Danish placings.
5. Points apply to Danish placings as follows:

a. High Blue – 4 points	c. Red – 2 points
b. Blue – 3 points	d. White – 1 point
6. Rider is only eligible for accumulating points in one Award Division. Rider must declare the division on their nomination form.
7. Novice in this division is for exhibitors in their first or second year ever of showing horses.

Category: Pleasure/Trail Riding

Description: For those that ride or drive their Regular Registry and Breeding Stock Paint Horses for recreation and leisure purposes.

Rules:

1. All RPHC current Year End Awards Qualifications and Rules apply. It is your responsibility to make sure you understand the rules, meet qualifications, select the appropriate division and category, turn in applicable forms, and keep accurate records.
2. Only time appropriately logged will count towards awards. Results are logged on the honor system and must be submitted by the deadline. Use the log included in this packet.
3. Time logged cannot be included when logging time for another category during the same event.
4. Riding or driving on State or Federal land counts for double the time.
